



SPECIAL PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY IN RELATION TO RISK OF CORONAVIRUS INFECTION

Thank you for reading this Agreement carefully. It includes important information about Camp Chaverim activities, and describes certain protection sought by Camp Chaverim if you, your child, or another family member becomes ill or suffers some other loss due to exposure and/or infection of the CoronaVirus (COVID-19) prior to camp, or may have been caused from being at Camp Chaverim, or from being exposed by someone else who came on to the Camp Chaverim campus.

In consideration of the services of Camp Chaverim, I, Parent, acknowledge and agree as follows:

Activities:

Camp is a place where campers, counselors, and staff are often in contact and near each other every day and every night. This includes, but is not limited to: eating at the table together at meals in the dining hall, playing sports like basketball, tennis, and volleyball where the sports ball is touched by many participants, and sleeping inside the cabins where cots and bunk beds are often less than six feet apart.

Risks:

At this point in time, the risk of contracting coronavirus is low. In addition, Camp Chaverim encourages and recommends all who are age-eligible to become vaccinated to further decrease the possibility that anyone will be exposed/contract covid-19. Anyone who is not fully vaccinated is required to have a PCR test within one week before the start of camp, as stated in our Covid Policy Letter.

However, the possibility still exists that campers will be exposed to the risk of contracting the Coronavirus. If a camper exhibits symptoms that our medical team determines requires a test, that child will be tested.



If Chas V'shalom the child were to test positive, parents would need to be prepared to pick up their child as soon as possible, no later than 24 hours after being notified. Any camper awaiting a test result in the infirmary will be required to wear an N-95 mask supplied by Camp Chaverim. Additionally, any camper that enters the infirmary while another camper is awaiting a test result in the infirmary will be required to wear an N-95 mask supplied by Camp Chaverim.

Testing for other campers will be done if our medical team determines it to be necessary. All campers will be treated as if they are in the same cohort.

Acknowledgement and Assumption of Risks:

I, Parent, have read and understand the Camp activities and risk of exposure to the Coronavirus. I acknowledge and assume the risks and dangers described above with my child being enrolled or employed at Camp. I have discussed the activities and risks with my child, who understands them and wishes to participate in the activities of the Camp community.

AGREEMENTS OF ASSUMPTION OF FINANCIAL RISK: I, PARENT, FOR MYSELF AND, TO THE EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW, ON BEHALF OF MY CHILD, AGREE THAT THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS OR PAYMENT GIVEN. THIS INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING SITUATIONS:

- **IF A CAMPER WAS EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH CORONAVIRUS AND BASED ON CONSULTATION WITH OUR MEDICAL TEAM, THE CAMPER HAS TO ATTEND CAMP LATE OR IS UNABLE TO ATTEND CAMP AT ALL.**
- **IF A CAMPER TESTS POSITIVE FOR CORONAVIRUS BEFORE CAMP, AND BASED ON AND AS A RESULT, HAS TO ATTEND CAMP LATE OR NOT AT ALL.**
- **IF A CAMPER TESTS POSITIVE FOR CORONAVIRUS DURING CAMP, AND BASED ON CONSULTATION WITH OUR MEDICAL TEAM, IT IS DETERMINED TO BE NECESSARY FOR THE CAMPER TO GO HOME.**
- **I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT MY CHILD DOES NOT HAVE AN UNDERLYING HEALTH RISK THAT PUTS THEM IN GREAT DANGER TO BE EXPOSED TO CORONAVIRUS OR MY SON IS VACCINATED. I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT IF MY SON DOES HAVE A HIGH RISK HEALTH CONDITION AND IS UNVACCINATED, WHICH PUTS HIM IN GREAT DANGER TO BE EXPOSED TO CORONAVIRUS,**



THAT I HAVE NOTIFIED THE DIRECTORS VIA EMAIL AND THEY HAVE ACKNOWLEDGED RECEIPT OF MY EMAIL.

AGREEMENTS OF RELEASE AND INDEMNITY: I, PARENT, FOR MYSELF AND, TO THE EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW, ON BEHALF OF MY CHILD, AGREE TO RELEASE AND DISCHARGE (AGREEING TO MAKE NO CLAIM, AND NOT TO SUE) CAMP CHAVERIM, AND THEIR RESPECTIVE OWNERS, MEMBERS, DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, CONTRACTORS AND VOLUNTEERS (INDIVIDUALLY AND COLLECTIVELY REFERRED TO AS "RELEASED PARTIES") WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL CLAIMS RELATED TO CONTRACTING THE CORONAVIRUS AND ANY LOSS, BODILY INJURY, OR DAMAGES ASSOCIATED FROM IT WHICH I OR MY CHILD MAY SUFFER, ARISING OUT OF OR IN ANY WAY RELATED TO HIM BEING ENROLLED OR EMPLOYED IN THE CAMP, AND ON OR OFF THE CAMP PREMISES. I FURTHER AGREE TO INDEMNIFY (THAT IS DEFEND AND PAY, INCLUDING COSTS AND ATTORNEYS FEES) THE RELEASED PARTIES FROM CLAIMS BROUGHT BY OTHER MEMBERS OF MY, OR MY CHILD'S FAMILY, AND CLAIMS BROUGHT BY OTHERS, INCLUDING OTHER CAMPERS, WHO CLAIM A LOSS CAUSED BY MY CHILD.

THESE AGREEMENTS OF RELEASE AND INDEMNITY INCLUDE CLAIMS CAUSED OR CLAIMED TO BE CAUSED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY THE NEGLIGENCE, BUT NOT THE GROSS NEGLIGENCE, OF A RELEASED PARTY. I UNDERSTAND THAT IN SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT I, FOR MYSELF AND FOR MY CHILD, TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW, SURRENDER THE RIGHT TO MAKE A CLAIM OR FILE A LAWSUIT AGAINST A RELEASED PARTY, FOR PERSONAL INJURY AND EVEN DEATH.

Any dispute between Camp Chaverim or another Released Party and me or my child shall be governed by the substantive laws (not including the laws which might apply the laws of another jurisdiction) of the State of Pennsylvania, and any mediation or suit shall occur or be filed and maintained exclusively in Franklin County, to the jurisdiction of which court or courts I hereby consent, for myself and my child.

If any part of this agreement is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the remainder of the agreement nevertheless will be in full force and effect.



This Agreement and Waiver of Liability does not supersede, circumvent, or cancel Camp Chaverim's Main Participation Agreement, but instead works together in conjunction with it.

I, Parent or legal guardian, have read and accept the terms and conditions of this Agreement, and acknowledge and agree that it shall, to the fullest extent allowed by law, be effective upon me and my child, and our respective heirs, personal representatives, estates and family members.
